Congratulations to Firefighter and department President Jerry Wittmer who responded to his 5500th career fire call with North Hampton VFD in February!

North Hampton accepted three new members in February, for a total of 5 new members in 2015.

Noteworthy incidents:

- NHVFD was dispatched along with HVFD and West Deer 3 VFD to the report of a shed on fire at a residence near Hampton High School. 165 Quint arrived on scene to find the contents of a block structure on fire. Fire was extinguished with approximately 1000 gallons of water
- NHVFD was dispatched to the Burger King at approximately 3am for the report of water flowing out of the door of the business. Crews entered the structure to find a broken pipe in the bathroom causing the problem. The water was shut off to the structure and the situation was turned over to management.

Training and Events:

Training for the month of February included the biannual CPR / First Aid /AED certification class (20 members in attendance) and the annual Hazardous Materials Operations Refresher course (16 members in attendance). Driver training, new member orientation as well as SCBA refresher training also took place during the month.
