### Noteworthy incidents and events:

- NHVFD assisted Hampton PD with a report of a cat stuck in a sewer in the 2400 block of Wildwood Road. Crews worked to gain access and were able to successfully remove the cat from the sewer.
- NHVFD was dispatched to the report of a vehicle fire in the 3900 block of Route 8. Crews extinguished a small engine compartment fire.
- NHVFD responded to a vehicle accident with entrapment in the 3800 block of Rt. 8. Crews arrived to find a two vehicle head-on accident with patients still entrapped in the vehicles. Crews extricated the victims, mitigated hazards, and provided fire police protection during the investigation.
