Noteworthy incidents and events:

- NHVFD was dispatched to assist multiple agencies with a large commercial structure fire in Etna Borough. Crews assisted with suppression and overhaul.
- NHVFD was dispatched for the report of an oil spill on William Flynn Highway. A truck leaked a large amount of fluid from Wildwood Road to Harts Run Road. Crews began the clean up process and provided traffic control for a professional haz mat company.
- NHVFD was dispatched to a vehicle accident with the vehicle on fire. Units arrived on scene to find a Subaru with all occupants out and an engine compartment fire. Crews extinguished the fire, assisted EMS with patient care and clean up.
