Noteworthy incidents and events:

- NHVFD was dispatched to a dumpster on fire in the 2600 block of Wildwood Rd. Crews arrived to find a 30 yard dumpster on fire close to the structure. Crews were able to extinguish the fire quickly and prevented any damage to the structure.
- NHVFD responded to a vehicle fire in the 4700 block of Route 8. Crews arrived to find a vehicle fully engulfed in flames. Crews extinguished the fire and the vehicle was towed from the scene.
- NHVFD responded as mutual aid to a residential structure fire in the 600 block of Westland Drive in Richland Township. Initial crews were able to quickly stop the spread of the fire and NHVFD assisted with salvage and overhaul.
- NHVFD responded to the report of a vehicle accident with entrapment in the 4500 block of Route 8. Crews arrived to find a two-vehicle accident with both drivers still entrapped in the vehicles. Crews worked to extricate both victims from the vehicles and assisted in closing the road for several hours.
