### Noteworthy incidents and events:

- NHVFD assisted Richland VFD with a dumpster fire next to a commercial structure on Kramer Rd. Crews assisted with extinguishment of the fire
- NHVFD responded to Wildwood Road Extension for a chimney fire. NHVFD Quint set up its aerial ladder to check for extension to ensure the fire was contained to the chimney.
- NHVFD responded to the intersection of Middle Road and Cedar Ridge Road for a reported motor vehicle accident with entrapment. First arriving crews were able to pry open the door and gain access to the patient. Crews also assisted with traffic control and containment of leaking fluids from the vehicles.
- NHVFD responded to Mt Royal and Trotter Drive for a reported motor vehicle accident over a hillside with entrapment. First arriving crews were able to stabilize the car and extricate the patient. NHVFD assisted with ground ladders and further stabilization of the vehicle.
