### Noteworthy incidents and events:

- NHVFD was dispatched to the report of smoke filling a residence on Wildwood Rd. Ext. Crews arrived and investigated and found burning wires on an exterior wall causing the smoke in the home.
- NHVFD was dispatched to the report of a vehicle accident with entrapment on Wildwood Road. Crews arrived to find a three vehicle accident with a large box truck over the hillside. Crews assisted with patient care and stabilization.
- NHVFD responded to the report of a fully involved pick up truck on fire on the PA Turnpike. Crews were dispatched to enter the turnpike going East Bound in the West Bound lanes in order to reach the fire. Crews extinguished the fire with the assistance of Richland VFD.

Training for the month included driver / operator training, SCBA emergencies and FF survival class.
